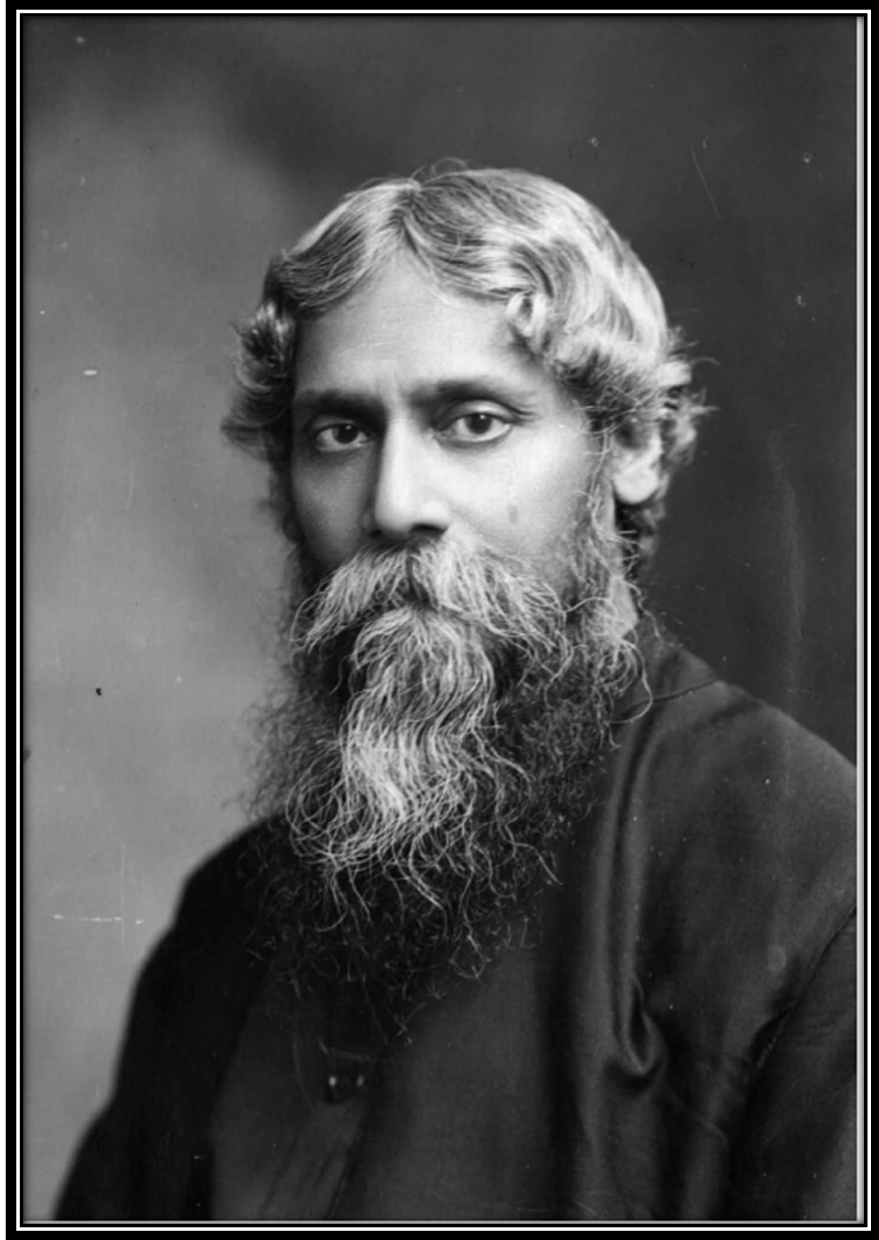

THE VISVA-BHARATI ACT, 1951

(NO. XXIX OF 1951)

An Act to declare the institution known as Visva-Bharati to be an Institution of National Importance and to provide for its functioning as a Unitary, teaching and residential university.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES FOR CERTIFICATE, DIPLOMA, ADVANCE DIPLOMA, POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA, SKILL DEVELOPMENT COURSE & FOREIGN CASUAL COURSE

1. Only current students of all Bhavana of Visva-Bharati will be eligible (Except Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma Courses of Kala Bhavana and all Post-Graduate Diploma and Skill Development Courses) for admission to Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma Courses.
2. The following categories of persons shall be eligible to apply for admission to Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma Courses in languages if they fulfil the below conditions
 - (i) Full time regular students of post-graduate, Under-graduate, Pre-degree Course and registered Ph.D. students of Visva-Bharati.
 - (ii) Regular full-time members of the Staff of Visva-Bharati.
 - (iii) Note: Since all the courses mentioned above are part-time language courses, students admitted to such courses shall be treated as "PART TIME".
3. Students against whom disciplinary action has been taken for indiscipline/anti-institutional activities etc. shall not be eligible for admission to the university academic programme.
4. Students must apply through ONLINE PORTAL: vbadmission.in. The Online application allows the candidate to provide all information and also to upload scanned photograph and signature.
5. **Application Fee: (Not refundable)**

6. The candidates are advised to safeguard their log-in id, email and passwords to prevent its misuse. In case of any mishap with id and password, it will be sole responsibility of the candidate.
7. It is advised to all the applicants to use email ID and mobile number (preferably WhatsApp) either of the candidates for his/her parents for direct/easy contact from the VB admission cell. Better not to use any contact number and mail ID of others or cyber cafe. VB admission cell may not be responsible for improper/incorrect mail ID and mobile number noted during online form fill up by the applicant.
8. Multiple applications submitted by an applicant for a single subject/program, the latest application will be considered for admission. Candidates must be very careful during the entry of the data/information. No claim shall be entertained subsequently for data entry mistakes committed by the applicant at the time of the online application. Incomplete applications are liable to be rejected summarily. The category declared in the registration form by the applicant shall be considered final while preparation of merit list.
9. Admission will be on the basis of merit list prepared on the marks secured by the candidates in the departmental entrance tests conducted by the concerned department.
10. Date of Entrance Test/Interview: The date of Entrance test/interview will be finalized by the concerned Department. Date, time and venue will be notified in the University Admission Portal- www.vbadmission.in
11. Venue of Examination: Respective Department/Centre of each Bhavana/Vibhaga (Institute) or as otherwise notified. In case of online admission test, modalities will be announced on university website/admission portal/Bhavana notice board in due course of time.
12. Qualifying marks for admission is 30% for General and 27% for OBC-NCL Candidates. No qualifying marks are required for SC & ST candidates. Qualifying marks for PWD as per Govt. of India rules.
13. Reservation of Seats: Reservation of seats for OBC-NCL SC, ST, EWS and Differently abled candidates will be made as per the rules of the Government of India.
14. Declaration of list of eligible Candidates: The Admission Coordination cell will publish the list of eligible candidates on the University admission portal: www.vbadmission.in.

15. Incomplete applications are liable to be summarily rejected. Rights to cancellation or admission lies with the Admission Committee of the Bhavanas / Vibhaga (Institute) concerned. The University reserves the right to restrict the number of eligible applicants to be called for admission test/interview.
16. The mode (online/ offline) of counselling/document verification for admission will be announced in due course.
17. Applicants are advised to visit our website (www.vbadmission.in) for any update (inclusion/omission) in connection with the entrance test, interview, counselling or physical verification.
18. Applicants must produce their original final mark sheets of all previous public examinations and other relevant documents along with self-attested photo-copies at the time of counselling/document verification to various courses failing which his/ her candidature will not be considered for admission. If any discrepancy is identified during verification, his/her provisional admission will be treated as cancelled. This should also be noted that the date of counselling/document verification may be announced 24-48 hrs before, including holidays. Applicants must be careful to ensure their candidature(s) for counselling/document verification for confirming the admission.
19. After successful verification, the selected candidates will get a payment link for paying the admission fee. They have to pay by logging in to their portal within the stipulated time. The selected candidates will be communicated via email and message about the activation of payment link.
20. The fee structure of the courses is already mentioned in the published e-Prospectus 2025 (Page no. 18) available on vbadmission.in. In case of Add on Certificate, Diploma & Adv. Diploma courses for which applicant pays double amount of admission fee with respect to few items (like Sports fee, Students Amenities fees, medical fees, Medical Insurance fees), the extra amount of fees will be refunded.
21. The applicants are advised to use their own/parents/guardians or relative's bank account for payment of admission/application fee. In case of cancellation/subject change or otherwise, an automated refund will be processed to the same account from where payment was made.
22. In case of online counselling/document verification, documents will be physically verified by the Department during physical class and if document is found incorrect the provisional admission will be treated as cancelled. Further, students have to submit the different undertaking forms, affidavits, and medical fitness certificates to the department during physical verification of the documents. All the related formats will be made available through the admission portal so that candidates may download to submit.
23. 25% of intake capacity at the university level will be made available for international students/foreign students including NRI on supernumerary basis. 5% of seats out of the 25% supernumerary seats for admission of foreign students shall be earmarked for children of Indian workers in the Gulf and South-East Asia.
24. All matters of dispute shall be taken to Bolpur Court District Birbhum under the jurisdiction of Calcutta High Court.

Note: Visva-Bharati remains closed on Saturday and Sundays, Rabindra Bhavana (Wednesday and Thursday) and Patha-Bhavana (Wednesday and Sunday). However, all the Bhavanas (Institutes)/Administrative offices work from 9.30 am 6.00 pm.
