**MSW Admission Test 2024**


Applicants are advised to note the following points:

1. Date of admission test: **01.08.2024 (Thursday- Written Test and Group Discussion) and 02.08.2024 (Friday-Personal Interview)**
2. Time of reporting: **9.30 am**
3. Venue: **Department of Social Work, PSV, Sriniketan-731236. (Nearest Landmark-Sriniketan BDO Office)**
4. Mode of test and marks: **Offline** mode; **Full Marks= 100** [Written: 50 marks (objective and subjective both based on general knowledge, current affairs and general intelligence); GD: 30 marks; Viva-Voce: 20 marks].
5. All candidates will have to appear for the **Written Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interview (all three methods)** to qualify for the admission test.
6. Witten test and Group Discussion will be held on 01.08.2024 (Thursday) after scrutinising the testimonials (i.e. Original Mark Sheet and other Certificates). Candidates are also advised to bring self-attested photocopy of every testimonials, certificates and other related documents along with resent colour passport size photograph to submit.
7. Viva-Voce will be held for all candidates who appear in the Written Test and GD on 02.08-2024 (Friday), from 10:30 am.
8. Candidates should collect **Admit Card** on the day of examination from the Department of Social Work.

9. Candidate should bring with them a copy of their respective application form, original government issued photo identity card (**Aadhar card/ Voter Card/ Passport/Driving licence**), complete result of previous examination passed if available (in original and photocopy) and caste certificate (in original and duplicate) and **blue ink pen**.
10. No electronic gadget (calculator, mobile phone, smart watch, etc) is allowed in examination hall.

12. Candidates are advised to visit university admission portal for necessary updates and information regarding merit list publication and admission dates. No phone call shall be entertained in this regard.
13. **All Applicants are requested to check carefully the eligibility criteria given below before appearing in MSW Admission Test.**

**Eligibility criteria for admission to MSW 2024**

- Passed Bachelor degree (Honours) or equivalent during **2023 and 2024** with 50% marks (for UR) & 45% (for OBC).
- Candidates should be from any one of the following streams: Social Work/ Science/ Commerce/ Humanities. The candidates from Humanities stream must have any one of the following subjects: History, Ancient Indian & World History, Economics, Sociology, Anthropology, Nutrition and Home Science, Psychology, Political Science, Public Administration, Geography, Philosophy, Religion, Management, Human Development, Education, Journalism and Mass Communication, English, Rural Studies & Physical Education.
- BSW students of Visva-Bharati with complete results are eligible for admission to MSW course as an integrated part of Social Work Education offered by the department
